<p>This can be organised as a 2, 3, or 4 week elective comprising exposures to various populations within the developmental/behavioural pediatric domain. Clinical exposures includes Spectrum Disorder evaluations and consultations as requested by inpatient.</p>

2, 3, 4 weeks			
Educational Objectives			
To learn the principle and fundamental tenets of developmental medicine in the pediatric context; also to gain some facility with the management of behavioural issues in children prior to the age of majority.			
Prerequisites			
Appropriate clinical exposures in the context of 2 <sup>nd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup> year medicine			
Scope of Work			
Observations; clinical interviews; history and physical examinations; intervention sessions (participation); information/feedback sessions (participation); reporting (in English and possibly			



in French); appropriate interaction with patients and families. All these tasks are done within the workday on Monday to Friday (generally approximately between 8 AM and 5:30 PM).

### Recommended Reading/Preparation

General reading of developmental topics such as learning disability, attentional issues, gender variance/identity, fetal alcohol spectrum disorder, autism spectrum disorder, language issues, motor issues (dyspraxia, etc.), medications for children.
